Matters discussed at the congregational meeting concerning setting minimum amounts for special offerings, the elimination of budget line items for Cadets and GEMS, and the possibility of procuring another church van were discussed and referred to the deacons for further review. Pastor Tom and Erin Dykman wish to thank the congregation for the anniversary blessings. They also ask for our prayers for the trip to Johnobie and this year's ministry. He leaves December 16, and goes counting on our continuing prayer support.
